

NEW HAMPSHIRE SUPREME COURT

ORAL ARGUMENT

APRIL 28, 2010

The Supreme Court will hold oral argument in the following case on April 28, 2010. Attorneys and parties are advised of the following:

1. Oral argument is scheduled to begin at 9:30 a.m. Counsel presenting oral argument must check-in at the clerk's office by 9:00 a.m.
2. The amount of time allotted to each party for oral argument is shown. The court intends to limit parties to the allotted time. Counsel should notify the courtroom monitor before oral argument if counsel intends to divide the allotted time or reserve a portion for rebuttal.
3. The justices will refrain from asking questions during the first three minutes of each person's argument; this period of non-questioning may be waived.
