SUPREME COURT

In Case No. 2008-0494, State of New Hampshire v. Sheila K. LaBarre, the court on July 28, 2008, issued the following order:

Defendant's motion to waive filing fee is granted. Attorney Richard A.S. Taylor and Attorney Alexandros S. Yiokarinis's motion to withdraw as counsel and appoint new counsel on appeal is granted. On July 25, 2008, the appellate defender was appointed to represent the defendant on appeal.

Case is accepted. The notice of appeal indicates that a transcript is required for appeal.

The Superior Court Center shall arrange for the preparation of the transcript, at State expense, as outlined on the transcript order form and to include opening statements, all recorded conferences, jury instructions, any response to jury questions, closing arguments and jury instructions and shall notify the clerk of the supreme court in writing that the arrangement has been made.

A copy of the notice of appeal, which includes the transcript order form, is being forwarded to the Superior Court Center with this order.

This order is entered by a single justice (Broderick, C.J.). See Rule 21(7).
