



Joint Administrative Order 2018 - 01

Video Testimony by Forensic Examiner

In all competency hearings, the forensic examiner shall appear and testify by video, unless either party files a motion with the court requesting that the medical examiner appear in person, and the court determines that in person appearance of the forensic examiner is necessary. The party filing the motion must notify the forensic examiner of the request for in person testimony. In addition, the party filing the motion must do so 10 days before the scheduled hearing and the motion must indicate with specificity the need for live testimony. For the purposes of this administrative order only, an objection to live testimony must be filed within three days of the filing of the original motion.
