**WHAT TO EXPECT AFTER YOU FILE
A MOTION**

You have filed a *Motion* with the court.

Motions are held by the court for ten (10) days. This ten (10) day period is the time frame the other party has to object to your motion, if they choose to do so.

After the ten (10) days the court will address your motion, and objection to your motion, if filed by the other party. The court's decision will be sent to you electronically.

Please be advised that if the other party objects to your motion prior to the tenth day, the court may address your motion without waiting the full ten (10) days.

If there is a court hearing scheduled and you have not received a ruling on your motion, you must appear at the hearing unless you hear otherwise from the court.
