
ORDER

Upon consideration of the public health concerns arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, and after consultation with the Chair of the New Hampshire Board of Bar Examiners, the Supreme Court adopts the recommendation of the General Counsel to the Office of Bar Admissions and authorizes the Board of Bar Examiners to administer a remotely-proctored Uniform Bar Examination on July 27 and 28, 2021, in place of an in-person examination on those dates. The remotely-proctored Uniform Bar Examination, which shall be prepared by the National Conference of Bar Examiners, satisfies the requirements of Supreme Court Rule 42, IV(a)(3)(A) and VII(a).

As soon as practicable, the Office of Bar Admissions will provide information to applicants concerning the remotely-proctored Uniform Bar Examination on July 27 and 28, 2021.
