


THE STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE  
SUPREME COURT OF NEW HAMPSHIRE  
O R D E R

Upon consideration of the public health concerns arising from the COVID-19 pandemic, and in furtherance of the April 10, 2020 order postponing the New Hampshire bar examination previously scheduled for July 28 and 29, 2020, the Supreme Court adopts the recommendation of the New Hampshire Board of Bar Examiners (Board) and orders that the New Hampshire bar examination be administered on September 9 and 10, 2020, at a time and place to be determined by the Board. Pursuant to Supreme Court Rule 42, VIII(a), the Board has extended the deadline from May 1 to May 15, 2020, for filing applications to take the New Hampshire bar examination and for filing completed petitions and questionnaires for admission.

As soon as practicable, the Office of Bar Admissions will provide additional information concerning the rescheduled bar examination.
