CRIMINAL CASES IN SUPERIOR COURT AND CIRCUIT COURT

Pursuant to its constitutional and statutory authority and powers of

general superintendence over the New Hampshire court system, and upon

consideration of the actions taken by Governor Sununu under RSA 4:45, the

Supreme Court issues the following order to safeguard an accused's right to

counsel during the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic.

Effective immediately and through May 25, 2020 and/or the last day of a

Declared State of Emergency, the procedural requirement set forth in RSA 604-

A:2 that a defendant complete a financial statement before the superior court

or circuit court appoints counsel is modified to allow (1) a court to appoint

counsel automatically for the defendant's arraignment or first court appearance

and (2) a financial statement to be submitted to the court on the defendant's

behalf for court review within 30 days of appointment.
